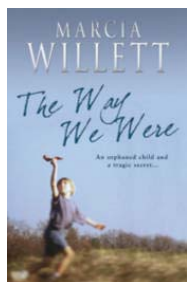


# New books @ your library

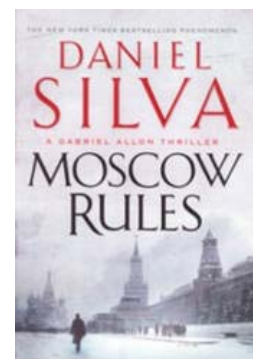
## THE WAY WE WERE—Marcia Willett (F/WILL)

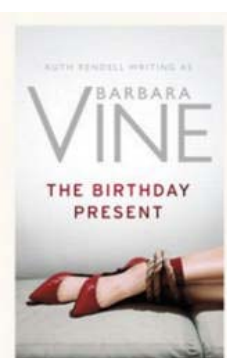


## THE INCREDIBLE LIGHTNESS OF SCONES—Alexander McCall Smith

Eastern Jewel craves freedom and will not be pinned down by anyone, least of all a man. Seductive, racy and completely original, The Private Papers of Eastern Jewel is an eye-opening and gripping re-telling of the real life of a fascinating but contradictory woman, a heroine who battled to juggle her extraordinary public life with her private paper demons.



## THE BIRTHDAY PRESENT—Barbara Vine (F/VIN)

It's late spring of 1990 and a love affair is flourishing between Ivor Tesham, a rising star of Margaret Thatcher's Conservative government, and Hebe Furnal, a stunning London housewife stuck in a dull marriage. On the eve of her 28th birthday, Tesham decides to give Hebe a present to remember: a fashionable new practice known as 'adventure sex.' A man arranges for his unsuspecting but otherwise willing girlfriend to be snatched from the street, bound and gagged, and delivered to him at a mutually agreed venue . . . Set amidst an age of IRA bombings, the first Gulf War, and sleazy politics, this is the gripping story of a fall from grace, and of a man who carries within him all the hypocrisy, greed and self-obsession of a troubled era.

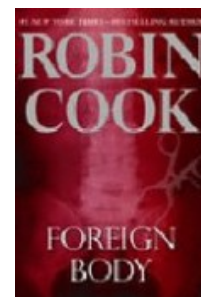


**THE WIDOW DOWN BY THE BROOK—**

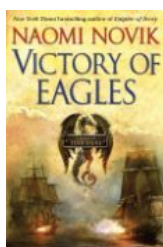
**FOREIGN BODY—Robin Cook** (F/COO)

Will Laurence, who serves Britain's peerless Aerial Corps in the thick of the raging Napoleonic Wars. Now, in the latest novel of this dazzling series, they soar to new heights of breathtaking action and brilliant imagination.

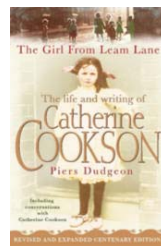
